

The above photo taken at Christmas time shows the center of a small suburb of Gstaad in the 'Saanenland' Canton of Bern. The name of this village contains six letters of the alphabet starting with 'G' and ending with 'g'! Often the name of this place is mentioned in conjunction with the neighbouring place of Feutersoey. The two places share the same Post Number 3781. If ever you want to visit this village by public transport you will most likely travel by train to Gstaad and then change to the Postal Car (Postauto) that takes passengers from Gstaad to Les Diablerets/Aigle.
