You are of course all aware of the rupture brought to our peaceful way of life by the 11 September terrorist attacks in the United States. Maybe you lost friends or even relatives. Our world has not only been badly shaken by those attacks; it has also become a more dangerous world, where personal and collective security have to be especially protected. I would like to tell you that the Embassy has been monitoring the situation in New Zealand and in the world very closely since 11 Septem-

Still, this is happily not the case thus far, and I note that, at least in Wellington, the pre-Christmas spirit is absolutely unbroken. This certainly goes for me and my husband, as well as for the Embassy team. Bernadette Hunkeler Brown, Lilach Guitar Nunéz, Louise Beale and Gabriela Hewson-Isenschmid all join me in wishing you all a Happy New Year for 2002.
