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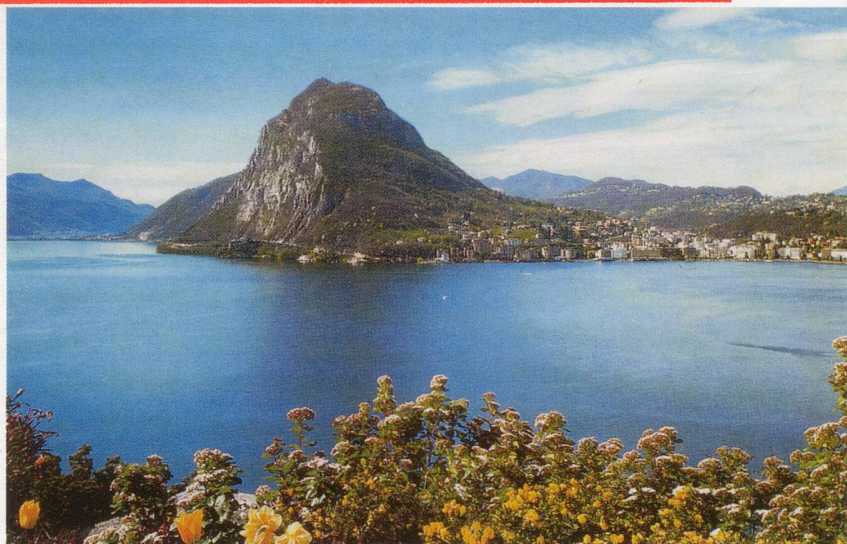
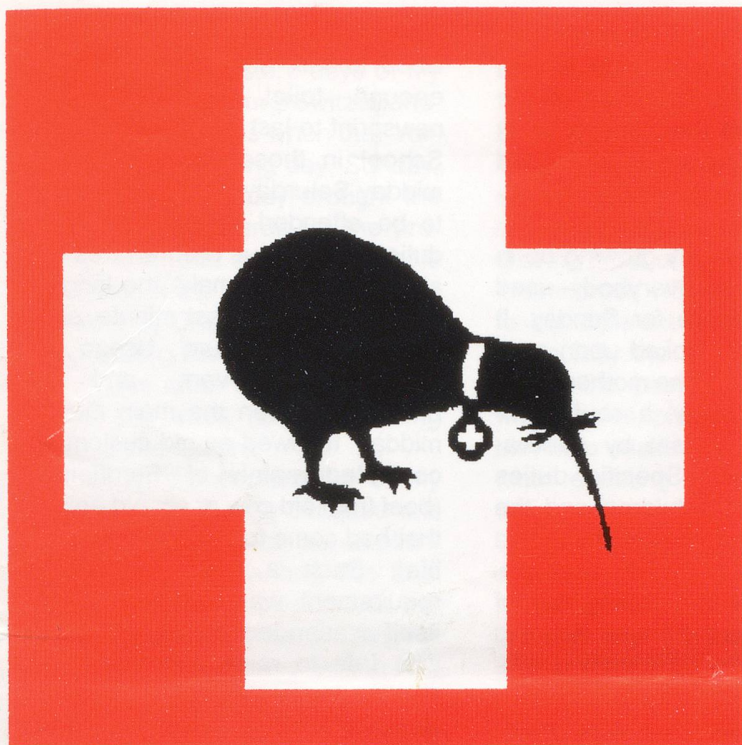

Do you know the name of this mountain in Ticino -Switzerland?

This mountain reaching to a height of 912 meters makes a beautiful backdrop to the picture of lake Lugano with the town in the foreground at the foot of the mountain. Lugano, a much loved tourist resort with its mountain, is in southern Switzerland's Canton of Ticino. Lugano is connected to the high speed railway net of SBB (Swiss Federal Railways). Taking a trip up the mountain people can reach the top by funicular from Lugano Paradiso (a five minute walk from Lugano railway station). The funicular takes 10 minutes to reach the top.

Arriving by car you would exit the highway at Lugano south to start the ascent of the mountain by funicular. As usual on Swiss mountains there is a restaurant awaiting visitors at the top of the mountain. Besides enjoying a panoramic view reaching all the way to the French alps, you could visit a small church and a museum at the summit.
