## Driving School

At the annual meeting of the Swiss Union Of Driving School Teachers, members complained at the lack of a 'tunnel-wise' driving programme in the curriculum. Although most teachers had already introduced some tunnel driving instructions into

their courses years ago, it was decided to draw up a national standard curriculum as a guideline for teachers.

The main concern expressed by teachers was for students to remember to switch on their car lights before entering a tunnel, which most learned drivers forgot to do.

Other areas of tunnel safety also caused concern, such as keeping bigger gaps between vehicles, first aid in tunnels, studying which tunnels have parallel emergency services and escape tunnels and how to use them.

The teachers' concerns and actions seem timely, when one thinks of Switzerland and its several hundred tunnels.
