News from Switzerland

The warmest month on record

With a hot day on 30 June came to an end a month that has rewritten the record books. The Meteo Swiss said that it had never been so hot on the north side of the Alps. On average the temperatures in North Switzerland were 7.0 to 7.5 degrees above the normal June temperatures. The average temperature in Zurich was 22.4 degrees. With a temperature of 36.5 degrees in Geneva on 25 June the absolute record temperature in Switzerland was achieved!!!

Our population reached 3 million in 1973, so it has taken nearly 30 years to gain 1 million more people! The population reached 2 million in 1951, and had reached 1 million in 1908.



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
