Swiss Architecture Exhibition: Wellington and Auckland

An exhibition entitled A Matter of Art - Contemporary Architecture in Switzerland, an exhibition presented by Jacques Lucan, will be displayed at the Schools of Architecture at Victoria University of Wellington and The University of Auckland. The exhibition came into being in 2000-2001 and is largely devoted to the presentation of sixteen buildings built between 1997 and 2001, providing an incisive 'section' of Switzerland's most recent architectural output.
