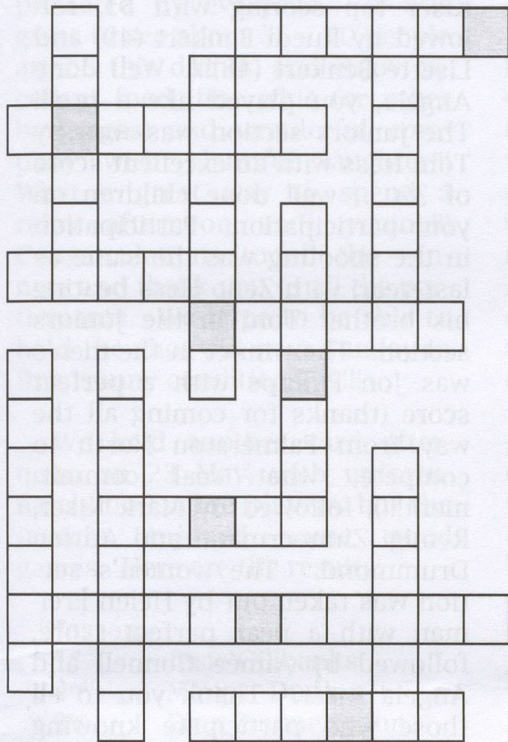

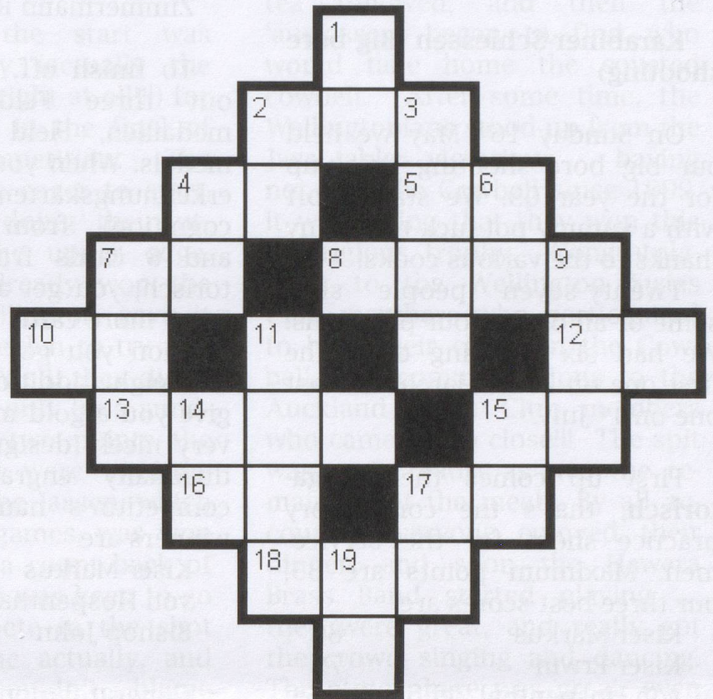
Can you enter the words correctly into the grid? The letters in the shaded boxes will spell out the name of the mystery word.
