Treasurer's Report for AGM 2018

The accounts have been reviewed by an independent party in May 2018. Based on the review, nothing has come to the reviewer's attention that caused him to believe that the financial statements didn't give a true and fair view of the financial position of the Swiss Society for the year ended 31 March 2018. Without modifying his conclusion, the reviewer drew attention to an adjustment made to the Members Funds which represented a minor re-statement of the Accumulated Funds as at 31 March 2017.

The Swiss Society of New Zealand has made a net loss of \$1,242 compared to a net profit of \$453 for the year ending 2017. The Swiss Society donated \$2,000 to Eli's assistance dog through Give a Little.

Six issues of the Helvetia were produced. The costs of the 6 issues was \$13,634. The income froms the subscriptions and adverts were \$17,125. A profit of \$3,490 for the year or \$581 per issue has been achieved.
