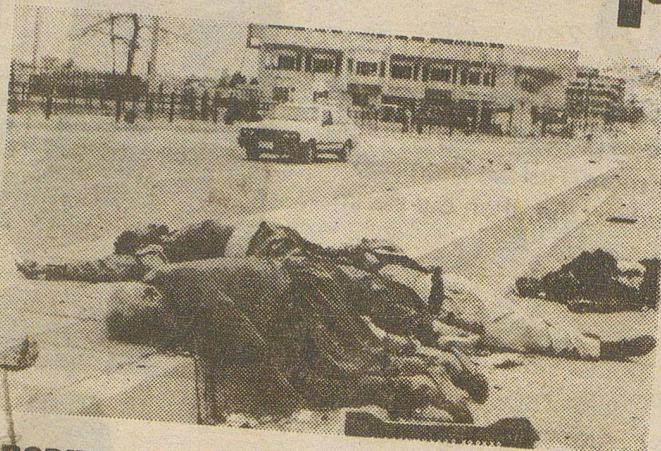

But France earlier declared the allies must act quickly to end the massacre of Kurdish and Shiite Muslim rebels and civilians bombed by Saddam's Republican Guard.

Foreign Ministry spokesman Daniel Bernard said his country was taking up the issue with fellow council members and UN Secretary General Javier Perez de Cuellar.

"It is urgent that the brutal repression striking the Iraqi population, notably Kurdish and Shiite, be ended," Bernard said.
