Nicola Abé is a political correspondent at the Berlin office of the German news magazine *Der Spiegel*. Previously based in Tel Aviv, she covered the Middle East for three years. Abé has been reporting from crisis regions such as Afghanistan, Iraq, and Nigeria since 2010. She studied political science in Munich and was trained as a journalist at Zeitempiegel School of Journalism in Reutlingen, Germany.

Gidon Bromberg is the Israeli Director of EcoPeace Middle East. He speaks regularly on water, peace, and security issues and has presented in front of the UN Commission for Sustainable Development, the United States House Committee on Foreign Affairs, the European Parliament, and the advisory meeting to the UN High-Level Panel on Security.

Mira Edelstein works in the Tel Aviv office of EcoPeace Middle East. She serves as the Jordan River Rehabilitation project coordinator, a project that includes cross-border cooperation for the ecological rehabilitation of the river, the promotion of cultural heritage in the valley, and which strives to advance the understanding of the significance of the Jordan River to faith communities.

Christophe Girot is Professor and Chair of the Institute of Landscape Architecture at the ETH Zurich. His teaching and research interests span new topological methods in landscape design, perception, and analysis through new media, contemporary theory, and history. His professional practice is focused on large-scale landscape projects, which contribute to sustainable urban environments.

Ben Gitai is an architect linking the disciplines of territory, landscape, and architecture in his practice. He is also a research associate and doctoral candidate within the DesignLab at the ETH Zurich. Engaging various scales, his projects explore layers of history in the Middle East and beyond, including his own personal history, through themes like memory, religion, social control, and utopia.

Ye'ela Gundar is an alum of the Arava Institute for Environmental Studies, Israel, and holds a degree in landscape architecture from the Technion – Israel Institute of Technology, Haifa.

Ita Heinze-Greenberg is an architectural historian whose research addresses the architectural history of the nineteenth and twentieth centuries. She has held teaching positions at various institutions in Germany, the Netherlands, and Israel;
