Since issue 2003/2, each volume of our journal has offered to the multi-disciplinary community of communication researchers both extensive *thematic sections* collecting papers covering each time a particular area of communication sciences (such as intercultural communication, health communication, television and new media) and *general sections* featuring contributions coming from the whole spectrum of disciplines that make up the field. In fact, we believe both in-depth focussing on complex emerging issues, and breadth of coverage are necessary components in a communication sciences journal.
