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SIXTA QUASSDORF studied English, general linguistics and philosophy at the University of Basel, and holds a PhD in English linguistics. She has published several articles on phraseology and quotation studies, as well as a monograph titled "A little more than kin": Quotations as a Linguistic Phenomenon, A Study Based on Quotations from Shakespeare's Hamlet (2016). Since then, she has leaned further towards literary and cultural studies. Her current research project – which she is pursuing as a post-doctoral assistant at the University of St Gallen – focuses on the representation of work in contemporary American fiction since the 1970s.

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
