ZACHAREAWITSCH—FELIA DORIO CONCERT.

Lovers of good music spent an enjoyable evening on the 4th inst. at Kingsway Hall, when M. Zachareawitsch, the great Violinist, gave a farewell appearance prior to his world tour, in conjunction with Miss Felia Dorio, the well-known Swiss Mezzo Soprano, to an immense audience which was unsparing in the bestowal of its warm appreciation of the splendid fare set before it.

M. Zachareawitsch was never heard to better advantage than in his chosen movement of Max Bruch's "G-Minor Concerto" and Bach's "Chaconne," which he rendered with the skill and technique expected from an artist of his calibre. At the close of his recital he gave as encore one of his compositions, entitled "Imagination," and was accorded an ovation by his enthusiastic supporters.

In Miss Felia Dorio, who gave a selection of songs by Brahms and Schubert, we have a singer who justifies her renommé as one of our best concert singers. Full round tones of even quality, unforced in the higher or lower register, made the recital a rare treat.

Miss Felia Dorio was the recipient of some very handsome floral tributes.
