## SWISS SPORTS.

On Tuesday, July 4th, by the kind permission of the City Swiss Club, the Committee of the Swiss Sports, with the representatives of the other Swiss Societies, met in the Club Room of the City Swiss Club.

The chairman, Mr. Georges Dimier, opened the meeting, and, after the reading of the minutes of last meeting, the assistant treasurer, Mr. H. Senn, gave a financial account of the last Swiss Sports, which had been duly verified by the hon. auditors, Messrs. de Wolff and Ruell.

We give below a balance sheet of the Sports, and it was proposed by Mr. E. Bloch, and seconded by the hon. secretary, that £20 should be allocated to the funds of the Swiss Benevolent Society. This proposition was carried.

The chairman then asked the gentlemen present to pass a hearty vote of thanks to all the gentlemen of the Swiss Colony and to the members of the different Swiss Societies for the handsome way in which they had kindly subscribed for our Swiss Sports, and he would again ask *The Swiss Observer* to publish a vote of thanks to all of them, and he would ask all the subscribers to accept these thanks, instead of getting another special letter from the Committee.

At the same time the chairman thanked all his colleagues in the Committee for the help given him, both in arranging and carrying on the work on the day of the Sports.

The year of office of the Committee being ended, they all resigned, and the following gentlemen were elected for the ensuing year:—Chairman, Mr. G. Dimier; Hon. Secretary, Mr. C. Kiefer; Hon. Ass. Secretary, Mr. F. Burgin; Hon. Treasurer, Mr. H. Senn; Hon. Ass. Treasurer, Mr. C. Aeschimann; Directors of Sports, Messrs. R. Duperaz and J. Sermier, further Messrs. E. Bloch, H. Nozières and R. E. Pfister.

A special vote of thanks for their great work in the past was accorded the four members of the late Committee who are leaving, viz., Mr. M. Pascaud, late Director of Ept. Mr. J. Oltramare, late Hon. Treasurer, and Messrs. Charles Studer and R. Hangartner.

The secretary was then requested to write to all the Swiss Societies, asking them to elect at their next meeting three of their members to act as their representatives at our Sports next year.

Before closing, the Committee asked the representatives of the Swiss Societies to make an earnest appeal in the Swiss Colony in London and encourage as many young Swiss as possible to engage in our Sports next year.

In conclusion, Tuesday, March 11th, 1924, was chosen for the first meeting of Delegates.
