TEN YEARS.

With the publication of this issue the "Swiss Observer" attains its tenth anniversary, and to mark the occasion we print below a brief summary of the more important happenings in the Swiss Colony reported in our columns during the period—

1920—1930.

From the Publishers' Introduction: ". . . The *Swiss Observer* will be run on independent lines—*independent of any party, creed or group—and its columns will be open to all shades of opinion compatible with Swiss honour, traditions and aspirations. It will exert itself in strengthening the existing societies in the Swiss colony by giving their reports and announcements a publicity they are unable otherwise to obtain. . . ."*
