SWISS CUP-FINAL 3rd APRIL.

Grasshoppers5 Urania1
 This match was played in Zurich (half time 2:0) before 18,000 spectators, Grasshoppers placing the identical team (except Pasche for Blaser) in the field as at the Crystal Palace against Corinthians. There was never any doubt about the winner. It might be interesting to put on record, how Grasshoppers won the cup this season. They successively beat Nordstern 6:1, Sparta Schaffhausen 10:1, Old Boys 11:1, Blue Stars 3:1, Basel 8:1, and Urania 5:1, or a total of 43 to 6 goals, and five of the six teams belong to the National League, our highest standard! So we undoubtedly did see the best Swiss team in London. Shall we laugh or shall we cry?

I am afraid that my old friends St. Gall are doomed and relegation must be their inevitable fate. Let us shed a tear of sympathy with the oldest Club in Switzerland in the hour of their affliction. Holding Zurich to a 3:4 score proves that they are not underserving; yet Basel's victory destroys their last chance. May they prove next year how quickly their old eminence can be regained. In the second Groupe, Young Boys take up 2nd place, 17 points, equal with Biel but a game in hand. Young Boys are now known as the "English team" and the expert advice and leadership of Bert Smith of the 'Spurs and O'Neill of Cardiff City begin to bear fruit. Servette have jeopardised their chances to escape, by their defeat. Still, they are only two points behind Old Boys who have played two games more, so there is yet time.

Groupe 1. The position of the relegation candidates remains unaltered. The Surprise is the second defeat of Lausanne-Sports in consecutive league matches. They still have 22 points from 13 games and are followed by Grenchen 17, Racing and Cantonal 16 points. No reason for getting excited.

Groupe 2 provides the greatest interest. The two top-notchers, Concordia and Locarno, lose unexpectedly, but Brühl make no mistake and seize their chance with both hands. Keep it up, boys and St. Gall will yet have a representative in the highest circle. And I shall be the first to congratulate you, old adversary though you may be. The table now reads:
