Servette made no mistake in Zurich, whereas Grasshoppers, 2 goals down at half-time, had all their work cut out to save a point at home. In the two Derbies in Basel and Bern, the town clubs bearing those names were successful, Bern by the narrowest result possible, their international left wing Bossi scoring. The leaders remain:—

In the First League "West" Racing now tie with Carouge for first place, the latter having a game in hand, however. In Group "East" Kreuzlingen were not engaged, but remain undisputed leaders with 16 points. Owing to that club's official declaration not to accept promotion to the National League if won, the second place becomes of vital importance and is fought for with great resolution. Any one of the seven might finish second, and I doubt whether that club will have Kreuzlingen's sagacity and decline promotion, with all the additional expense it means and which has led several of our old and renowned clubs to the very brink of ruin. The old lion of Winterthur narrowly escaped relegation to the Second League last year. There does not seem much hope left this year. A pity!
