Grasshoppers did Servette a very good turn the previous week, by beating their nearest rivals, Lausanne. This week they proved their impartiality by obliging Lausanne with their surprise victory in Geneva. Incidentally the Grasshopper Club did themselves a good turn, advancing to fourth place in the table with 25 points from 22 games. Servette and Lausanne tie for first place, 31 points each, Servette one game in hand. Third remains Lugano, but only two points separate them now from the leaders. The championship is once more becoming an open question. That Nordstern should beat Young Fellows in Zurich is all against form and Y. F. drop from 4th to 7th. Bern remain 5th, but Basel 6th and Biel 8th have changed places. Young Boys were disengaged, playing a "friendly" with the Freiburger F.C. and drawing 2:2. Concordia have gathered two points in Geneva, but who would not?

In the First League Luzern have pulled up their socks, beating Zurich 2:0 and my inconsistent friends F.C. St. Gallen should have their pants let down for losing 4:1 in Schaffhouse! F.C. Brühl on the other hand easily accounted for Chiasso by 4:0 and displace their local rivals from second place. Such is life! In the other group, Aarau have strengthened their position at the expense of Monthey, but their nearest contenders, Olten and Grenchen both also won. Here too, it is still anybody's championship.

On the 7th April, Grasshoppers are reopening their enlarged ground, to accommodate 30,000 spectators. The burnt down stand is rebuilt and quite a stupendous programme has been arranged. On Easter Monday the Corinthians visit Zurich and during the month of May matches against F.C. Sochaux, Wiener Sportclub, Wolverhampton Wanderers and Manchester City are contemplated. Grasshoppers are living up to their reputation and it is gratifying to see, from their games against Lausanne and Servette, that they have run into form.
