SPORTS EVENTS.

Ice Hockey.

The Swiss Ice Hockey Championship ended at the beginning of February and the Skating Club Zurich gained the title of Swiss Ice Hockey Champion. This is the second time that this Club finishes the ice hockey season with the glory of a Swiss champion, the first Swiss title was earned in 1936. The final league table reads as follows:—

The Ice Hockey world championship is at present taking place in Stockholm. The participating countries number ten teams including Switzerland. The preliminary rounds have already taken place and Switzerland reached the final round, together with the teams from Canada, Sweden, Czechoslovakia, Austria and U.S.A. Favourites for the world title are Canada and Czechoslovakia with Sweden and Switzerland as outsiders.

In the preliminary rounds Switzerland was beaten by the U.S.A. 12:5, but gained victory over Belgium 18:2 and over Norway 7:1.

Ski-ing.

The Ski Club Kandersteg has organised the Swiss Ski-ing Championship for the 50 km. race. The track was considered by the competitors as difficult and the snow was heavier than usual.
