**ANGLO-SWISS SOCIETY.
DINNER IN HONOUR OF SIR LIONEL LAMB
AND LADY LAMB.
at Londonderry House, Park Lane, W.1.
on Friday, 4th December, 1953.**

Sir Lionel Lamb, the newly appointed Ambassador to Switzerland received a very cordial "send off" on the occasion of the dinner given in his honour by the Anglo-Swiss Society.

The Rt. Hon. Philip Noel-Baker, M.P., P.C., President of the Society was in the Chair.

As the occasion warranted, there were a number of after dinner speeches, all, without exception, not only brilliant but most appropriate.


