# PERSONAL.

We greet with great pleasure the arrival in London of Mr. Pierre Louis Lorsignol to join the Swiss Bank Corporation as a Manager of the London Office.

Mr. Lorsignol comes to the United Kingdom with a long record of international banking experience, for in his earlier years he worked with the Banque Franco-Chinoise in China and subsequently with the Banque de Paris et des Pays Bas in Paris.

At the time war broke out in 1939, he was due to go to New York as one of the founder-staff of the Swiss Bank Corporation's new office in Nassau Street, but the French Army claimed his services.

Subsequently he worked with the Banque Nationale pour le Commerce et l'Industrie in Dakar and thence proceeded to Rabat in Morocco as Chief of the Exchange Control. joined the Swiss Mercantile Society in 1916.


