COMMUNIQUE FROM THE SWISS LEGATION.

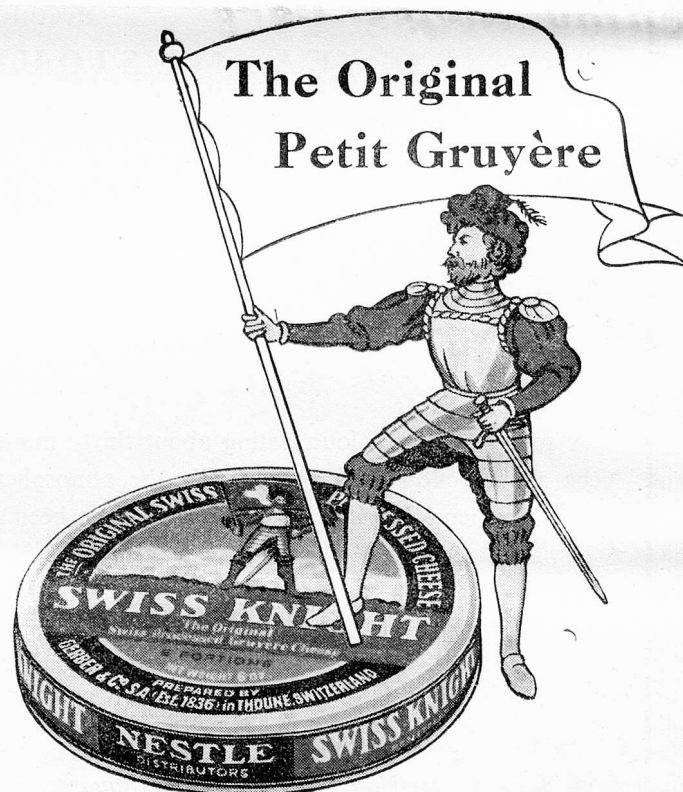
**Damage occurred as a result of the occupation of the
Federal Republic of Germany and of West Berlin.**

A law on compensation for damage occurred as a result of the occupation of these territories came into force in the Federal Republic of Germany and West Berlin on 4th December, 1955 ("Gesetz über die Abgeltung von Besatzungsschäden").

This law concerns damage caused by American, British or French occupation agencies, during the period from 1st August, 1945, to 5th May, 1955, on the present territory of the Federal Republic of Germany and of West Berlin. Damage occurred before or after this period is outside the scope of this law, and so are damages connected with reparation and/or restitutions.

Applications for compensation must be submitted, *before the 3rd June, 1956*, direct to the appropriate German authorities ("Amt für Verteidigungslasten — ehemals Besatzungskostenamt") of the locality where the damage occurred.

COMMUNIQUE FROM THE SWISS LEGATION.

War Damage sustained by Swiss Nationals in Belgium.

An arrangement between Switzerland and Belgium came into force on 28th January, 1956, whereby the Belgian Government have agreed to pay compensation, amounting to 50% of that accorded to Belgian nationals, to Swiss physical or juridical persons whose property was destroyed or damaged as a result of acts of war on Belgian territory during the Second World War.

If this has not already been done, the damage will have to be notified *before the 1st July, 1956*, to the appropriate Belgian authorities ("Direction provinciale des dommages de guerre") of the locality where it occurred. This notification, which must be in writing, need only indicate the date and the nature of the damage. The Belgian authorities will then send the necessary forms to the applicant, with instructions how to complete them. This obligation to notify war damage applies also to all those who have already completed forms at the request of the Federal Political Department, since these latter forms were intended only for internal Swiss administrative purposes and cannot be passed on to the Belgian authorities.

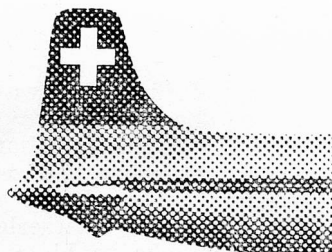

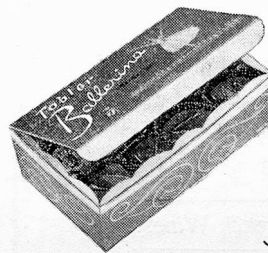
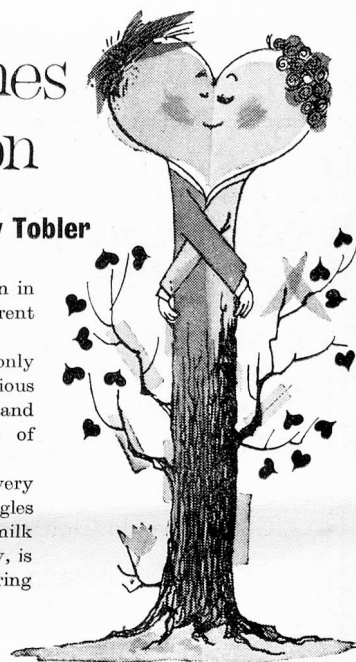
