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
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APPEAL.

Dear Compatriots,

As you no doubt know, one of the big events during our Swiss Fortnight this autumn will be a Charity Ball at the Dorchester Hotel on the 6th of October. The Ball is in aid of the British Pastalozzi Children's Village, and is sponsored by the Anglo-Swiss Society and the Embassy. It is hoped to hand on that occasion to Sir John Wolfenden of Reading University, the Chairman of the British Trust, a substantial donation in order that a "Swiss House" could be built on a property already acquired near Battle, in Sussex — a worthwhile reciprocal gesture for the two British Houses maintained by the Trust at Trogen. Already over £3,000 have been collected, mostly from private donors in Switzerland. hoped to raise the rest of the money needed through this Charity Ball.
