We extend sincere sympathy to Mr. and Mrs. Ermanno Berner, of "Berner House", West Bradford Road, Waddington nr. Clithero Yorks., Mr. Berner's father, Ernesto Berner, having passed away at Bergamo at the age of 87.

The departed, a citizen of Sion (Ct. Valais) was a successful businessman, and Swiss Consular Agent in Bergamo. He was one of the most respected and popular members of the Swiss Colony in that town, where he was affectionately called "Papà Berner".

Ernesto Berner was a devoted family man, and a great humanitarian giving comfort and help to all people in need. During the two world wars, he was in the front rank amongst the workers helping prisoners of war regardless of creed or race.

The generous tribute paid to him by the Italian Press on his demise were sure proof of the love and veneration in which Ernesto Berner was held.
