F. DANNMEYER †

We deeply regret to announce the passing away of Mr. F. Dannmeyer, of 11 Ravensdale Avenue, North Finchley, N.12, at the age of 82.

The deceased was born at Basle, where he received his schooling at the "Primar" and "Realschule", and later joined the "Schweiz. Bankverein".

Following the urge of so many young Swiss in those times to go abroad and seek their fortune, he left for Paris, and early in this century — about 1902 — he arrived in this country, obtaining a post with a London financier.

Successively he held various positions in stockbroking and commercial firms. Everywhere he worked he was highly esteemed for his integrity and his dependability.

Soon after his arrival in London he joined the Swiss Mercantile Society, of which he was elected President in 1905. This post he held until 1909. Some years ago he was presented with the bronze plaque given by the "Schweiz. Kaufmännischer Verein" to members of fifty years' standing.

The departed joined the City Swiss Club in 1906, and four years ago was elected an Honorary Member, having been associated with this well-known Club for fifty years. He was married to an English lady, who died some seven years ago.

All those who have known F. Dannmeyer will keep him in affectionate memory. ST
