SWISSAIR TO SERVE KHARTOUM

Return flights leave Khartoum on Wednesday afternoon. The new flight, offering first and tourist class accommodation replaces Swissair's Tuesday service to Kuwait and Dhahran, which will be temporarily supsended from the end of April.
