ZURICH'S INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL WEEKS

Although June remains as before the principal month of the Zurich International Festival Weeks, the first performance of Richard Strauss's "Salome" is to be given on 30th May, followed by a festival performance of "Aida" on the following day. Similarly, the Playhouse is to begin its festival programme with Max Frisch's "Don Juan" on 30th May and then switch over to the programme of guest performances titled "Shakespeare in Four Languages". The first of the festival concerts at the Tonhalle will take place on 2nd June, when Karl Böhm is the conductor. — For the first time the "Theater am Hechtplatz", which may well be called the pivot of Swiss cabaret art, will participate in the Festival Weeks, featuring the famed quartet from Paris "Les quatre Barbus". — The Kunsthaus will be host to works of art from Swiss private art collections, and the Museum of Applied Arts is to review "Theatre decorations since 1945".
