A SWISS SCIENCE COUNCIL

The Swiss government recently set up a Swiss Science Council. The aim of this organisation is to acquire an overall view of the measures taken by the Confederation, the Cantons and private enterprise in the field of science and research, to draft the necessary co-ordinating plans, give its opinion on the steps considered by the Confederation and to suggest others of its own whenever they should appear necessary. The advice it gives is to be based on all the essential elements of a scientific, financial, economic and political nature so that the Government's scientific policy — an extremely important part of its functions — should be in accord with its structure and the other tasks incumbent upon it. It may call upon experts to assist in the study of certain problems.

For the moment, the Swiss Science Council is composed of thirteen members from Swiss scientific, university and industrial circles, including the Government Delegates responsible for atomic energy and opportunities for work, the President of the Federal Commission of Experts for the Study of Aid to the Universities, the President of the Research Council of the Swiss National Fund for Scientific Research and the President of the Council of the Federal Institute of Technology.
