

An invitation to you, your family and friends.

Dürrenäsch, devoted to the Fifth Switzerland — the "Home" for Swiss living Abroad — set amid beautiful scenery between Wynen and Lake Hallwil has just entered its 2nd decade.

To celebrate this occasion a hearty and cordial invitation is extended to you, your family and friends, whether they are Swiss or non-Swiss, to spend an ideal and interesting winter holiday at Dürrenäsch from 1st September 1967 to 30th April 1968.

Indulge in your hobby while holidaying in the very heart of rustic Switzerland!

During your stay you may indulge in your own favourite hobby or, if you wish, participate in various community projects such as handicrafts under the tuition of master Swiss craftsmen or join sightseeing tours or take part in various sports and games or just relax and enjoy the magnificent surroundings of the forests and hills.

What would it cost?

During these jubilee celebrations accommodation including all meals is reduced by 50% from Fr.19.25 to **Fr.9.65 (16s.) per person per day**. If guests are willing to undertake the minor tasks involved in looking after their own rooms, these prices will be further reduced to **Fr.8.15 (13s. 6d.) per day per person**.

Also during this period there will be a considerable reduction in travelling costs. *All fares will be reduced by 10% to 100% according to the length of stay:*

by 100%	for 6 months

„ 33½%	„ 1 month
„ 25%	„ 2 weeks
„ 10%	„ 1 week.

This concession will also apply to your family and friends providing you travel with a party of not less than 10 people.

Two examples:

- All-in costs for a party of 10 leaving London for Dürrenäsch (Switzerland) on a *two weeks' holiday* (incl. meals, accommodation and return fare): £24 3s. 7d. per person resp. £22 8s. 7d. for those doing their own rooms.
- All-in costs for a party of 25 leaving Manchester for Dürrenäsch (Switzerland) on a *two months' holiday* (incl. meals, accommodation and return fare): £60 9s. 6d. per person resp. £51 8s. 0d. for those doing their own rooms.

A further benefit is available to Swiss nationals who are entitled to draw the Old Age Pension and who will be staying at least 4 months in the "Home". They may, although never having contributed to the Swiss National Pension Scheme, receive a special supplementary payment which will be allowed them in connection with this visit.

All of us at Dürrenäsch are waiting to welcome you back to your homeland with your relatives and friends. Our objective is to make you feel that you have really come HOME with all that this word implies. A genuine and really heartfelt welcome awaits you and yours in our truly happy community in beautiful Dürrenäsch. Please do come!
