THE SWISS PRODUCT WITH THE OLDEST TRADE MARK

In Switzerland and abroad, all gourmets and cheese lovers know and love "Schabziger", the herb cheese from Glarus. From times immemorial, this speciality with its very distinctive odour has been manufactured in this Swiss Canton, from curdled milk mixed with the leaves of a special aromatic clover, dried and reduced to powder, which gives the product its greenish colour. As long ago as 1464, the assembly of the citizens of Glarus passed a very severe regulation governing the manufacture of "Schabziger" and decreed that all the small rounds of this excellent cheese — which is eaten grated and mixed with butter — should bear a special mark so as to protect consumers against imitations. For over five hundred years therefore, this cheese has been officially known as a product of the Canton of Glarus, but its manufacture goes back much further into the past, since we have reason to believe that it was introduced by the monks who were converting the country, some time in the seventh century. A MULTI-PURPOSE AIR-CONDITIONING AND HEATING PLANT FOR THE HOME

The economic development of the last decade has led in many countries to very marked requirements for increased comfort in the home. The most vital of these concern heating, air purification and hot water supply, and all of these are supplied, in the most practical manner, by the "Lukomat" multi-purpose installation. Designed and built by a firm at Romanshorn, it consists first of all of a boiler running on fuel oil or solid fuels as required, and even on refuse of all kinds, a hot water supply plant heated by the same boiler and an air-conditioning plant. The last of these comprises a number of fans which suck in the fresh air from outside and the stale air from inside, filter it, mix it in proportions permitting the gradual replacement of the air, and heat or cool it depending on the season, the heat being supplied by the boiler and the cooling either by running water or, in extreme cases, by a special cold generator. "The "Lukomat" plant (we cannot enter here into details), is cleverly designed and can be provided with entirely automatic control, by means of thermostats, hygrostats, etc. Special filters ensure the purity of the air fed into rooms in which the pressure is slightly higher than that outside, which prevents any possibility of cold draughts in winter; the air is humidified when necessary by means of steam, supplied by the boiler. The whole plant, in its different models and sizes, is built compactly, completely equipped with the necessary cables and a remote control device. The elimination of radiators contributes to the beauty of rooms while simplifying the problem of painting; in addition, the hot air pipes are fitted after the concrete flooring has been laid, which simplifies construction.
