WILD ANIMALS FOR EXPORT

The Basle Zoo is known all over the world for its successful breeding of wild animals in captivity. Many of the animals living there are genuine citizens of the Rhine city by birth and, to judge from the statistics, many other animals born in Basle are now in foreign zoos. In fact, while during the last ten years the Basle Zoo has bought nearly 600,000 francs' worth of animals, during the same period it has sold nearly one million francs' worth. The sales included 4 rhinoceros, 1 okapi, 14 dwarf hippopotami, 15 zebras, 15 Bengal tigers, 9 black panthers, 13 leopards, 12 pumas, 8 caracals, 16 servals, 15 lions, 4 bears, 3 giant kangaroos, 20 llamas, 11 marsh antelopes, 12 dwarf zebus, 22 moufflons, 102 dwarf goats, 19 emus, 20 royal lorikeets (parrots), 40 bald ibises, 7 laughing jackasses, 62 peacocks and many other animals.

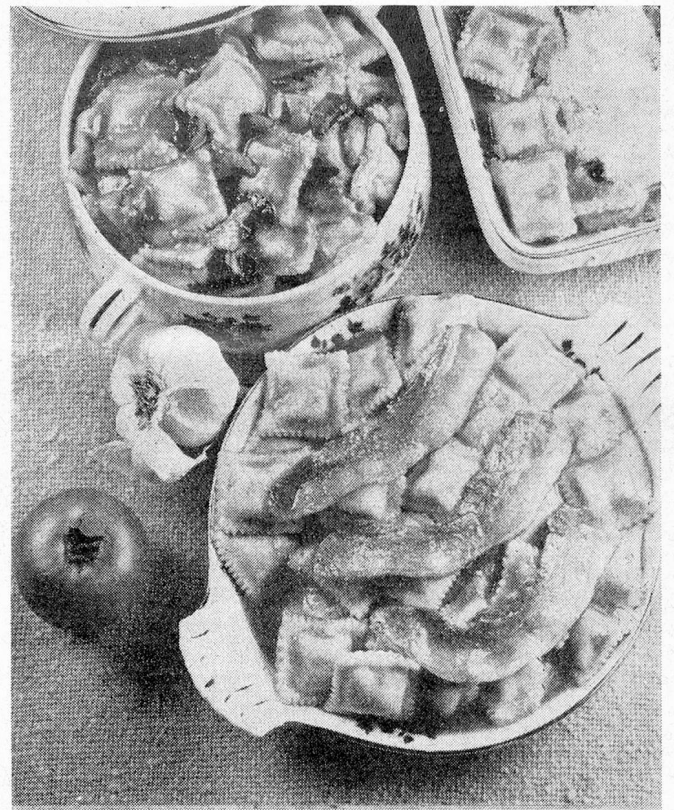


