PHILIPP SCHMID-RUEDIN

It is with deep regret that we announce the death of Mr. Philipp Schmid-Ruedin, former National Councillor and Honorary President of the Swiss Mercantile Society in Switzerland. He died on 22nd February at the age of 82.

Philipp Schmid came from the Grisons and loved to recall the days when he was a young goatherd. But his intelligence, his clear mind and his wish to work for humanity soon took him away from the mountains of his

beloved Bündnerland.

For several decades he influenced the whole movement of commercial employees, more precisely the "Schweizerische Kaufmännische Verein". He began as Central Secretary, and from 1930 to 1956, he was General Secretary and finally, from 1956 to 1962, Central President. He devoted his whole life to the improvement of the, at that time, very bad conditions of work and old age of commercial employees.

It was inevitable that he should use his strong and persuasive personality in politics, and he was elected National Councillor in 1925. For 38 years his voice was heard in the good cause of providing for old age; he was one of the initiators of one of the greatest social achievements in Switzerland, the old-age and invalidity insurance. Philipp Schmid advocated it at a time when politicians of high rank called it an illusion. For many years he was chairman of the Parliamentary Democratic Panty, and also a member of the Council of Europe. As Swiss living abroad we have every reason to be grateful to him, for he had our interests at heart at all times and was one of the powerful supporters of the Constitutional Article for the Swiss Abroad.
