## ENGADINE SKI MARATHON – 12th MARCH, 1978

Each year, at the beginning of  
March, about ten thousand enthusiasts  
gather in the Engadine area of  
Switzerland to compete in the "Ski  
Marathon", Switzerland's biggest cross-  
country ski-ing event.

This season's event, the 10th  
Engadine Ski Marathon, is open to those  
born before 1958 and takes place on 12th  
March, 1978. The route is Maloja  
(5,960 ft); Isola; Sils; Surlej; Silvaplana;  
St. Moritz; Pontresina; Samedan; Bever;  
Zuoz; S-chanf (5,487 ft).

Applications must reach the  
organisers by 1st February. Forms are  
available from: 10th Engadine Ski  
Marathon, 7514 Sils-Maria.

A special "Ski Marathon Training  
Course" is organised from 6th to 11th  
March for participants of the Engadine  
Ski Marathon. The Course costs

There will be a small toll charge.

## MARBACH – NEW WINTER CAMPING SITE

A new camping site has been  
opened at Marbach in the Entlebuch  
(Central Switzerland). In addition to 30  
equipped caravans on the site there is



room for holidaymakers' own caravans or  
tents. With an aerial cableway and several  
ski-lifts, Marbach and Escholzmatt are  
ideal areas for winter sports.

with a capacity of 1,000 persons per hour each. The total capacity of the mountain transports as Riederalp has thus been increased to approximately 7,000 persons per hour.

### SAAS-FEE (5,905 ft), VALAIS

A new aerial cableway with a total carrying capacity of 1,000 persons per hour will be opened this winter between Spielboden (8,036 ft) and Laengfluh (9,414 ft) above Saas-Fee.

### SCUOL-TARASP-VULPERA (4,101 ft), GRISONS

From 23rd to 28th January, the Swiss Ski Team will have their final practice session for slalom and giant slalom before taking part in the Alpine World Ski Championships at Garmisch. Scuol-Tarasp-Vulpera will thus be offering this winter a special downhill ski run, slalom and giant slalom run, all approved by the International Ski Federation. The Swiss Alpine Junior Ski Championships will be held at Scuol from 10th to 12th February.

### WITH STONE AND BROOM IN SWITZERLAND

The 1977/78 fixture list of the Swiss Curling Federation, which has its headquarters at Wildhaus in the Toggenburg region, contains more than 700 tournaments. About 300 of the contests will take place in the 15 larger

indoor curling rinks such as Arlesheim (near Basle), Berne, Biel, Grindelwald, Geneva, Lausanne, Thun and Wallisellen near Zürich. In Switzerland there are more than 90 winter sports resorts and towns in which curling enthusiasts can indulge in their hobby. Various resorts are also offering inclusive curling weeks this winter, e.g. Davos (to 12th March), Flims (to 5th February and 5th to 12th March), Lenzerheide (to 4th February) and Grindelwald (to 4th February).

### DISCOVER SWITZERLAND BY EUROPABUS

The Swiss Postal Coach Passenger Service is again organising escorted tours from April to October, 1978.
