SULZER BROS (UK) LTD RECEIVE ORDER FROM MANCHESTER UNIVERSITY FOR UNITOP TURBO PACKAGED REFRIGERATION PLANT USING HEAT RECOVERY

Sulzer Bros (UK) Ltd have received an order from Manchester University for a UNITOP turbo packaged refrigeration plant and its integration as a standby unit into the air conditioning system of the university computer room.

The Sulzer UNITOP will be used to chill water from 8.0°C to 5.6°C. Heat recovered from the condenser will be used to preheat heating service water from 41.4°C to 46.0°C. A double bundle condenser will be used, one bundle for heat recovery service and the other for cooling tower operation which will cool water from 34.4°C to 26.7°C.

SWISSAIR TAKES OPTION ON THIRD BOEING 747

In accordance with its long-term fleet planning, Swissair has decided to take an option on a third Boeing 747 with a delivery date in the spring of 1982. This is in keeping with expected traffic development, notably on the routes to the United States.

The two DC-10-30s on order will, as scheduled, be delivered next February and March. Swissair is maintaining its option on a further DC-10-30.


SWISSAIR OFFERS LOW APEX FARES TO SWITZERLAND

From 1st November Swissair has introduced low advance purchase excursion fares (APEX) between the UK and Switzerland. The new fares from London to Basle, Geneva and Zurich represent a 50 per cent cut on present normal economy return fares and cuts of up to 31 per cent on existing excursion fares. Similar reduced APEX fares will also be available on Swissair's services between Manchester and Zurich.

The APEX return fare London to Basle or Geneva is £80.00 and to Zurich £84.00, subject to government approval. Booking and ticket issue have to take place at least one month before travel. Return travel may not take place less than seven days after outward travel, except that where outward travel takes place on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday or Saturday, the return is permitted between the following Sunday and Wednesday. Ticket validity is three months.

APEX capacity is offered on most Swissair flights between the two countries. A 50 per cent refund is allowed on change of reservation or cancellation made earlier than one month before departure.

APEX travel to Switzerland is available on both Swissair and British Airways flights and tickets will be interchangeable.
