THE collapse of Sir Freddie Laker's cut-price airline came just as Laker Airways was preparing to launch its London-Zurich route, which would have been the company's first regular service to the European continent.

The fortunes of Sir Freddie have always been followed closely by the Swiss media, and his bankruptcy duly received extensive coverage in the Press here.

Ironically, the Laker collapse followed closely an award by the Swiss-based European Management Forum honouring his company as one

of Europe's top pioneering enterprises.

The prestigious non-governmental Forum praised Sir Freddie's "pioneering, innovative and competitive aggression, and his long and tenacious fight against many and powerful vested interests."
