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
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Take a turn at the Swiss Roll



ANSWERS to the clues should be entered with the first letter in the numbered space indicated by the clue number and then proceeding outwards.



If you fly over Switzerland instead of




It is better to land at Zurich, Geneva or Basle and treat yourself to the feeling that staying is much more pleasant than leaving.
