Paravicini in view of the very great services he has rendered to us Swiss during the last twenty years. As the Committee particularly wish that every member of the Swiss Colony should be able to contribute to the presentation to be made to the Minister, a maximum amount of 2/6d. per person has been fixed.

A farewell dinner at which the presentation will be made will take place at the Monico Restaurant, Piccadilly Circus, on December 15th, at 6 p.m. (not evening dress). Ladies will be particularly welcome. The price of the tickets has been fixed at 7/6d. each, exclusive of wines, etc.
