## TWO PUBLICATIONS FOR THE SWISS ABROAD

Earlier in the year we already mentioned the informative booklet "Die Fünfte Schweiz" (La Cinquième Suisse, La Quinta Svizzera) which has been published by the Organisation of the Swiss Abroad in Berne. As is well known by now, 1966 has been specially dedicated to the Swiss nationals who live outside their homeland, and the Organisation has marked this year by a number of special events. The elaborate celebration in April in the Basle *Rathaus*, the special edition of the "Echo", journal for the Swiss abroad, the special stamp, an extended Assembly of the Swiss Abroad in Berne and various other important events inside Switzerland in the course of the year are the milestones in "the Year of Fifth Switzerland", which will, we sincerely hope, have its crowning by the Swiss electorate accepting the Constitutional Article concerning the *Suisses de l'étranger* on 16th October.

Two of the publications are available now, one is the issue of a postcard which may be had at Fr. 3.— per dozen and which can be used to remind our Swiss friends and relations to go to the poll in October and support the unanimous acceptance of the Article by both Federal Chambers. The postcard is brilliant blue and shows the signet of the Swiss Abroad, the globe and the Swiss flag. It is the same design as the special stamp issued earlier this summer.

The design also serves for the cover of the interesting booklet mentioned above which gives a survey of the Swiss *présence* in the world. The author is Dr. Edmond Müller, Director of the Secretariat of the Swiss Abroad, and the former Federal Councillor, Prof. Dr. F. T. Wahlen, wrote the preface (see First of August number of "Swiss Observer" on 22nd July).

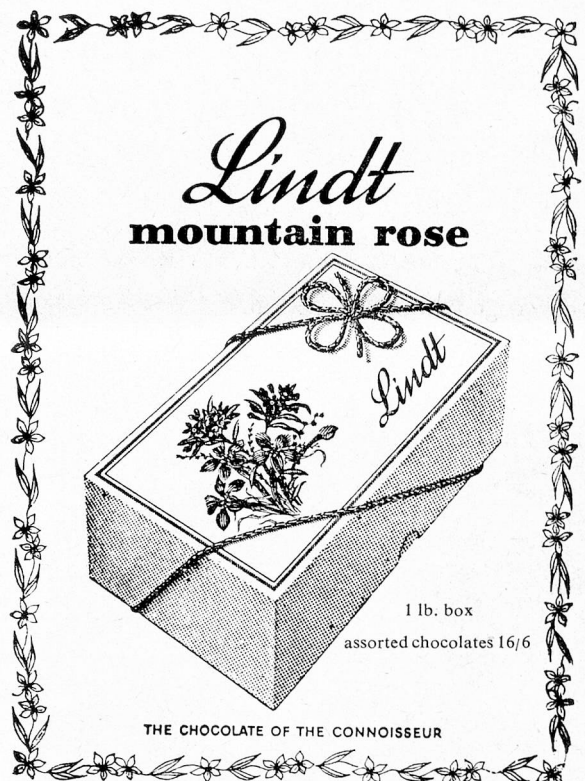
## AN IMPORTANT REMINDER

## A NEW RESEARCH CONTRACT

A contract has recently been signed between Ciba Laboratories, Horsham (Sussex) and the Bethesda Health Institute, Maryland, which is subordinate to the American Ministry of Health, Education and Social Security. This contract covers a research plan to be carried out by the Ciba Organisation in Great Britain. This company will attempt to establish a relationship between the quantities of pharmaceutical products resorbed and their clinical effects on the human organism. It is intended to provide the Ciba research laboratories at Horsham with a clinical biochemistry department whose task will be to perfect new methods permitting the determination as exactly as possible of therapeutical and toxicological properties of medicaments. The Ciba medico-pharmaceutical research centre at Horsham was inaugurated in May 1965 and it the fourth of the research establishments operated by the Ciba Group. [O.S.E.C.]
