

The Berne-Lotschberg-Simplon Railway forms one of the main arterial routes of Europe, threading the wild and dangerous Swiss Alps through Europe's highest standard gauge tunnel. The railway is of increasing importance, its largely single line mountain section is being rapidly converted to double track to handle an even greater volume of international traffic.

Distinctive milk chocolate coloured locomotives haul smart blue and cream passenger cars intermingled with those of the SBB, Italian, French, German, Belgium and Dutch railway systems. Colourful freight trains also march through the Alps in a steady procession linking the industrial towns of northern Italy with commercial centres in the rest of Europe through the Simplon Tunnel.

The BLS and its constituent companies also run trains to Interlaken, Zweisimmen, Belp, Schwarzenberg and Neuchatel. These and the Alpine route connecting the Rhone and Kander valleys are all thoroughly covered in this exciting, action packed video programme.

The hour long programme is being made with the full co-operation of the BLS management who have accorded us unique filming opportunities.
