NEW VESSELS FOR LAKE LUCERNE

This year will see the introduction of three new vessels, designated *Panorama 300* by the SGV. The first, named *Weggis* was delivered early this year, the remaining pair, *Brunnen* and *Fluelen* are due in November. Built by Deggendorfer Werft, the provisional dimensions are given as:

<i>Length</i>	48.4 m
<i>Beam</i>	9.2 m
<i>Displacement</i>	281 tonnes
<i>Passengers</i>	300
	176 inside
	124 outside

There are no immediate proposals to take any of the present fleet out of service. No doubt the company will need all available capacity for the 1991 anniversary celebrations.

The names are new to the SGV fleet.
