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Dampfbahn Furka-Bergstrecke

Services will be operated on the DFB (the restored Furka summit line of the FO) on Saturdays and Sundays from 11 July to 11 October between Realp and Tiefenbach. The core services depart from Realp at 14:10 and 15:20, arriving at Tiefenbach at 14:28 and 15:38 respectively. The return workings leave Tiefenbach at 14:40 and 15:50, arriving at Realp at 14:59 and 16:09. In fine weather, trains will run from 10:30 at 1hr 10min intervals, and an extra service, leaving Realp at 16:30, returning at 17:19 may run under favourable conditions during July, August and September. Rochers De Nayé

Steam returns to the Rochers de Nayé line every Saturday and Sunday in June and September between Caux and the summit, subject to good weather. Groups of 30 or more can hire a special train from May to October. For service runs one needs a valid ticket and to pay a steam supplement of SFr.5. Steam trains will leave Caux at 10:45, 12:45 and 14:45 and return from Rochers de Nayé at 11:35, 12:24 and 15:35. It is also expected that the old electric MGN 2 will be working with a vintage coach.

Bauma-Hinwil

Steam services will again be running this year. On Sundays 19 July, 2 and 16 August and 18 October trains will lave Bauma for the 40 min run to Hinwil at 09:30, 13:30 and 14:30, returning at 10:30, 14:30 and 16:30. On Sundays 5 July, 6 and 20 September and 4 October. Additional trains will leave Bauma at 10:30 and 14:30, returning at 11:30 and 15:30. These will be either steam or electric hauled and will enable a change of train at the intermediate station of Baretswil.

Club Vapeur Aigle

We have been informed by this society that their International Festival of Steam will be held at Bouveret from 18 to 21 June. There is an extensive network of tracks for live steam models, in particular, passenger hauling types. The site is close to Lac Leman, and is near the route on which preserved standard gauge steam is likely to be working that week-end.
