As a result of a recent visit to Switzerland the following may be of particular interest to members.

Hochstrasser Exklusive Modellbahnen in Luzern now deals only in specialist models, mainly brass - ie Lemaco, Fulgerex, Lok14, Bayard, HRF. There are no conventional mass produced models at all.

Members on a budget will be pleased to know that they can visit the model railway (and the shop & cafe) at the Verkehrshaus for free as this is now designated as a free public access area - useful if you just want to nip in to see the trains

run and haven't the full day available to see the whole museum.

Roland Born in Rapperswil has some of the best prices in Switzerland for Roco, Lima and Fleischman as well as unusual items and exclusives at affordable prices. You must visit if in the area.

I am led to believe, on very good authority, that talks are in progress re the production of an HO model of an S-Bahn set. It is likely to be a limited run and probably more highly priced than mass produced stock, but still in the realms of reason. Details should be available after the summer.
