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## FROM THE MEMBERSHIP SECRETARY 1999 RENEWAL

The renewal form for 1999 subscriptions is included with this issue. **ALL** renewals should be forwarded **directly** to the Membership Secretary. Members in the USA, Australia and New Zealand will still be able to pay with the appropriate dollar cheque but this must be included with the renewal form and forwarded to the Membership Secretary. Subscriptions have been held at their 1998 levels except for Europe and 'Rest of the World'. The latter reflects the extra postage involved. It is possible for all overseas members to pay in sterling, but please note, this must be by cheque or draft payable in the UK and **drawn** on a **UK bank**. (Very high bank charges are imposed on us for individual sterling cheques drawn on foreign banks and thus cannot be accepted. This charge would be in addition to the surcharge paid for conversion at the time of your purchase.)

The following members have prepaid for '99; OF135, OJ105, OK106, OP100, OS142 and T74.

Please include a small, stamped, **unaddressed**, envelope (we will use a pre-printed label) with all **UK renewals** for the return of your membership card - it will **NOT** be included with the March mailing of Swiss Express.

As the number of renewals is ever increasing (933 so far) - excellent news - it would be most helpful if no other correspondence requiring a reply is included, but it is one of the more pleasant aspects of the office to receive comments and updates on your visits etc. It is regretted that it is not possible to accept and process post dated cheques.

The aim is to give a speedy and efficient service and members should know their renewal has been received and processed by the return of their membership card and the encashment of their cheque.
