With scale drawings for each type, plus photos, this is an essential RhB reference work, 256 pages, 169 black/white photos, 359 scale drawings (43 in colour), plus 20 plans etc. German £43.85.

Schweizer Bahnen: Unterwegs in die Zukunft. History and development of each section of the Swiss railway system over the past 150 years. 168 pages, 85 black/white and 29 excellent colour photos, 17 maps and diagrams. German. £24.85.

Images de Trains III. Main and branch lines, industrial systems and preserved lines all feature in the third (all colour) volume in this fine series, covering the more recent past of the varied French railway scene. 184 pages, 370 colour photos. French £43.50.
