1998 RhB Calender, Historische Dampfzüge from MITV, price £12.95 + £2.00 p&p. Address in ads.

This is definately one for the RhB enthusiast who likes to see the RhB's steam engines in action. The calender measures 48cm wide by 33cm deep. The cover is a sepia picture of Rhatia, inside there are twelve different pictures in colour

of the various steam locos in single and double traction, plus two of the steam snowplough. The quality and the views are very impressive. There is a separate page for each month. There is an extra page after the calender with a fahrplan from 1889. Details of the places the photos were taken and a list of various events taking place in 1998 on the RhB.
