This was the period of use of the SBB Railway Stamps which were sold to consignees of parcels and freight from 1 March 1913 to 31 May 1960 to prepay the charges raised by the Railway Company.

A letter to the SBB archives has produced a response regarding the use to which these labels

were placed but without any details of the rates.
