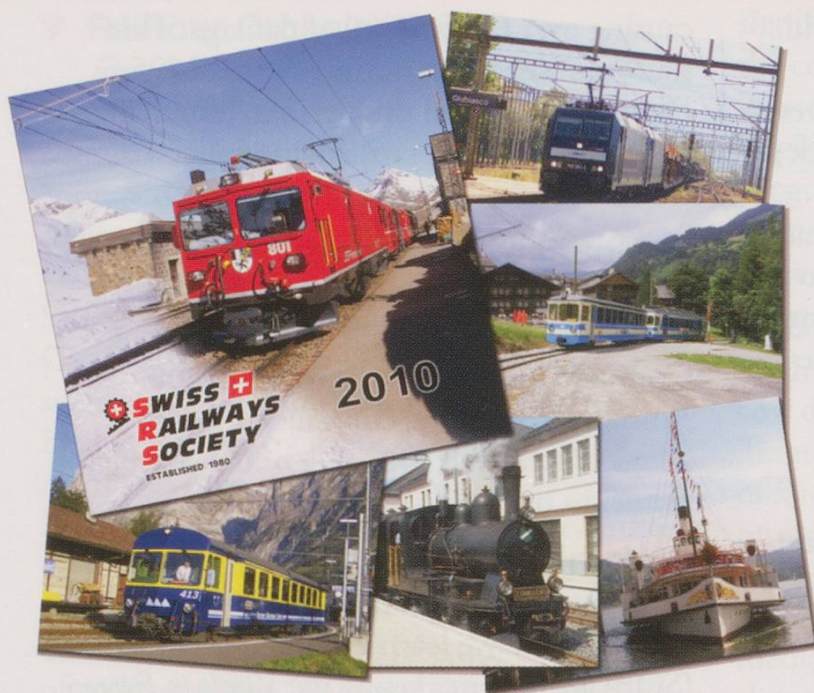

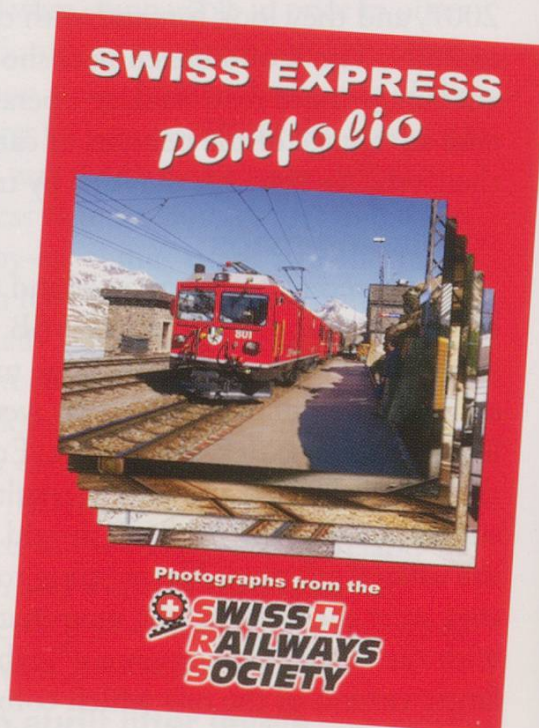
(including postage) will be £10 to UK members and £11.50 for Europe and the rest of the world.
