In Basel and want to experience all kinds of DB trains? You can see the whole gamut, from locals to Class 403 class ICs, by taking a 10-minute (generally free of charge as tickets are rarely checked, but potentially nerve-wracking) trip on any train going from Basel SBB to the DB's Basel Badischer Bahnhof. The Border is at the DB station but, as usual with Schiengen, it is open and without controls. Tickets are normally only checked after northbound trains have left here. Occasionally frontier inspections take place, without fuss, between Basel Bad. Bhf. and Freiburg im Breisgau. At Basel Bad. Bhf. you get off and either return the same way, or you walk outside and take a green BVB tram on Line 2 back across the river to the SBB station. The north end of the station is also a great place for train pictures, with many international freight trains, much engine changing, and the sun behind you. It is of course always better to have a ticket, which you can buy at the machine, or if you are resident in a hotel they should give you one that is valid across Basel for the whole day. **+**
