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
## Tribute.

On 4 July 2006, at only 64 years of age, Notker Buchegger was suddenly torn from the midst of his dedicated working career. Through his death, Switzerland Tourism has lost a valuable and much appreciated executive staff member who dedicated 41 years of his life to the enterprise. During the past three years he was engaged as head of the department Finance, Controlling & Organization and a member of the Executive Board.

Notker Buchegger's career initiated at the Schweizerische Verkehrszentrale – Swiss National Tourist Office – in June 1965 as employee in the accounts department. His commitment continually led to new positions: office boss, office manager, head of the Organization/IT department and finally member of the Executive Board.

Notker Buchegger knew all ST staff members personally. He also knew and was familiar with all ST agencies, most of which he had helped establish. As a broadminded cosmopolitan he opened many doors for ST and was an excellent networker. He died after serious illness shortly before his retirement.
