270°C Colder thethirdeye.agency

Around 11 months ago, I moved into a small house at the northern edge of the city. My roommates are different kinds of spiders, cockroaches, mosquitoes and some other foreign creatures whose names I do not know. Actually, I am a foreigner myself.

In principle, we share all the space in this house. But it seems like every creature has their own addiction to certain kinds of space: Spiders like corners, cockroaches like somewhere with foods, mosquitos like me...

The form of the small environment in my house reminds me of a model for a social structure and its corresponding space and time. At the ETH on Hönggerberg, space and time are also shared by different human beings with different social identities: At around 05:30 in the morning, the staff of the logistics center of ETH is receiving mails and packages from the Post, and at the same time the cooks of two canteens start to prepare the meals of the day; the cleaners from vebego Schweiz Holding AG must arrive at around 6:00 and some of them finish their work at around 8:00 on working days. Most of them are recent immigrants, the time when they finish their work should be the time when the «professors», «students», «researchers», «assistants» just begin theirs. At around 19:00, maybe most of these decent identities are leaving their working place, heading for another space called home; at around 20:00 the staff from the post office comes to empty the postal box; from 22:15 the Sicherheitsdienst of the night shift start checking if all the space is in a state called safe; if it is summer, after midnight, crickets start chirping for courtship at the parking lot of the A floor in HIL.

I cannot remember since when, it seems that everyone and everything has a schedule, but some of the schedules stand on the edge of the prevailing reality. We sense each other over invisible boundaries and pretend to be stable in the turbulence of desire and fear.

It is so cold, but where could we go, the average temperature of the universe is even 270°C colder.

~ 07:00 Transport was leaving logistics and the left empty space in logistics center.


Adrien was driving to deliver mails and packages, we encountered with the worker from the construction site on Hönggerberg.

~07:30 The encounter of *transport* and *cleaning*




~ 08:30 Marcelo and the schedule of the *transport*, when the chauffeurs were back to their garage for a coffee break.
